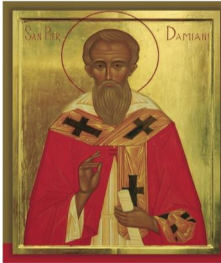
Informational Night for Parents with a Child with a Disability

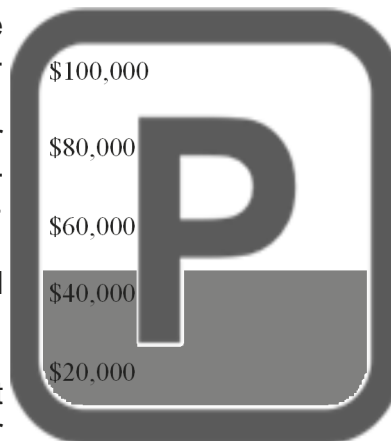
West Side Eagles Jr Football
