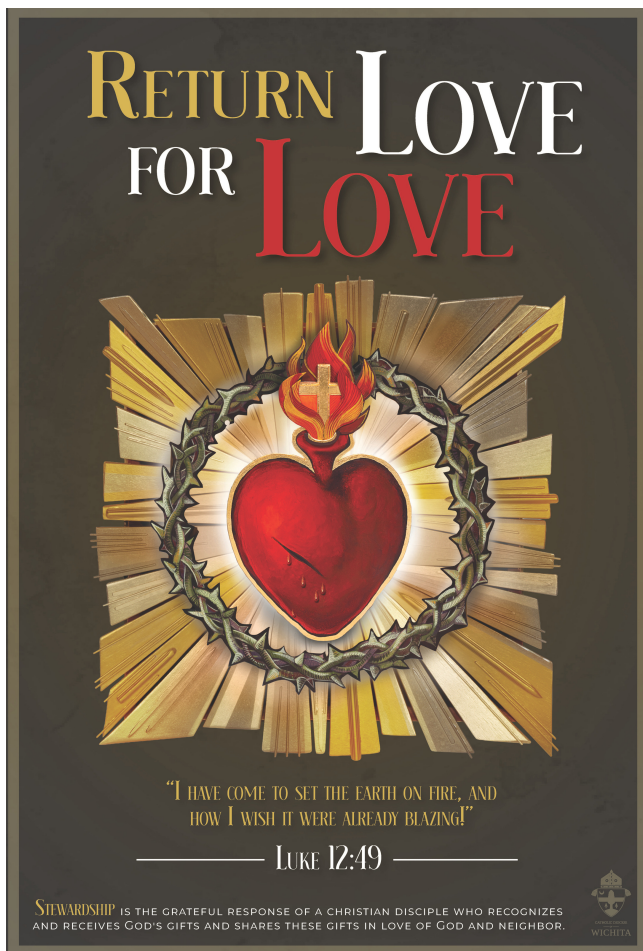

HOSPITALITY

Create a welcoming parish home through food, fellowship, and personal connection.

Cookie Baking

Provide homemade baked cookies for the monthly Mass for the sick, parish gatherings, receptions, and special events as needs arise.

Funeral Dinners

Prepare, donate, serve, or cleanup for meals offered to families following a funeral.

Harvest House (55+)

Join adults age 55 and older for prayer, fellowship, service, learning, and social activities.

Parish Greeter / Hospitality

Welcome parishioners and visitors, answer simple questions, and help people feel at home. Youth may serve with a parent.

Rectory Meals Ministry

Cooks take turns providing a dinner meal for the priests on Fridays. Schedule is coordinated in advance.

School Greeter

Offer a warm welcome to students as they arrive and are dropped off for school.
M-F 7AM-8AM

PRAYER

Strengthen the spiritual life of St. Anne by praying with and for our parish family.

Eucharistic Adoration

Commit to a regular hour of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament or serve as a substitute when an adorer is unavailable. Family adoration available on Tuesday's evenings.

Intercessory Prayer Team

Team members pray intentionally for those that would like intercessory prayer after Mass on the 1st Sunday of each month during the 9am and 12:30pm Masses.

Marian Mantle

Gather in prayer for loved ones who have fallen away from the practice of the Catholic faith. English: Mondays at 6pm(gathering space) Spanish: Tuesdays at 4pm (church)

Prayer Line

Receive prayer requests for parishioners in need and offer faithful prayers.

Rosary Leader

Lead the rosary before Mass or at designated parish prayer gatherings after receiving guidance.

Traveling Shrine

Host the parish shrine in your home for a designated week and pray together as a household, family, or group.

FORMATION

Help children, youth, adults, and families grow as disciples of Jesus Christ.

High School Youth Group

Students in grades 9-12 grow in faith through prayer, community, formation, and service.
Meeting on Wednesdays 6 PM-8 PM.

Oración Carismática (Spanish)

A Spanish-language charismatic prayer and formation community centered on praise, Scripture, and life in the Holy Spirit. Meet every Wednesday 7 PM-8:30 PM

Transformed by Christ

Participate in a formation experience that helps adults deepen their relationship with Christ and live as missionary disciples.

Baptism Preparation Assistant

Assist the Baptism Preparation team by welcoming parents and godparents, preparing materials, setting up the meeting space, helping with registration and attendance, and providing general support during classes and Baptism celebrations.

Confirmation Catechist /Assistant

Accompany young people preparing for Confirmation by serving as a catechist or assistant and supporting lessons, discussions, prayer, activities, and service.

VIRTUS REQUIRED

Marriage Preparation Leader /Assistant

Accompany engaged couples as they prepare for the Sacrament of Matrimony by using the parish formation process.

OCIA Sponsor

Walk with an adult seeking full initiation into the Catholic Church by sharing faith, encouragement, and parish life.

PSR Catechist

Teach and accompany children or youth in the Parish School of Religion using the approved curriculum. English: Wednesday evenings / Spanish: Sunday mornings

AGE 16+; VIRTUS REQUIRED

PSR Classroom Assistant

Support the catechist with classroom activities, hospitality, and student engagement. English: Wednesday evenings / Spanish: Sunday mornings

AGE 16+; VIRTUS REQUIRED

LITURGICAL MINISTRIES

Serve the Church's public worship with reverence, preparation, and hospitality.

Altar Server

Assist the priest during the Liturgy of Mass, open to both male and female.

GRADES 5th-8th

Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion

Assist with the distribution of Holy Communion at Mass after approval and training.

PASTORAL APPROVAL

Homebound Ministry

EMHC commissioned to take Holy Communion to our parishioners who are homebound and unable to attend Mass.

PASTORAL APPROVAL

Mass Captain

Men aged 16 and older who feel called to serve the church in a significant manner help the priest during the Mass liturgy and ensure the altar servers are properly supported.

MEN, AGE 16+

Music Ministry

Serve as a cantor, choir member, instrumentalist, organist, or pianist to support the sung prayer of the Church.

TRYOUT/APPROVAL MAY APPLY

Offertory Gift Bearers

Individuals or families present the gifts of bread and wine during the offertory at weekend or special Masses.

Reader

Proclaim Sacred Scripture with reverence, clarity, and conviction, ensuring it is done prayerfully after proper formation and approval.

AGE 16+ & PASTORAL APPROVAL

Sacristan

Women play a crucial role in the Mass by preparing the sanctuary and sacred vessels prior to the service and taking care of liturgical items afterward.

WOMEN, AGE 16+

Usher

Welcome and seat parishioners and guests and assist during Communion, support the offertory collection, and address any practical needs as they come up.

SERVICE

Share practical gifts that keep our parish, school, events, and outreach ministries thriving.

Altar Society

Women support the liturgical and community life of St. Anne through service, fellowship, and care for parish needs.

WOMEN, AGE 18+

AC Repair

Offer skilled help with air-conditioning assessment, maintenance, or repair when requested by parish.

Adopt a Room

Take ownership of the regular maintenance, organization, and minor enhancements in your designated school classroom.

Building Maintenance

Become a part of the team dedicated to identifying and addressing repairs and enhancements throughout the St. Anne campus.

Church Cleaning

Prepare the church for weekend Masses and special liturgies by sweeping, vacuuming, dusting, and cleaning to ensure it looks beautiful and inviting. Saturday mornings.

Communications

Assist with writing, editing, translating, organizing, or distributing communications for the parish and its ministries.

Evening Lockup

Assist in securing the parish campus facilities during the evening by following the established checklist.

AGE 18+

Flower Garden

Enhance the campus by planting, weeding, watering, and maintaining the parish flower beds. Youth are welcome to participate alongside a parent.

YOUTH MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN.

Front Desk Aide - Parish

Assist in the parish office with clerical tasks, welcoming visitors, answering phones, and preparing materials. Various schedules are available. Bilingual English-Spanish volunteers are preferred.

Front Desk Aide - School

Assist in the school office with occasional clerical tasks and welcoming students, families, and visitors as directed. Various schedules are available. Bilingual English-Spanish volunteers are preferred.

VIRTUS REQUIRED

Knights of Columbus

Catholic men serve the parish and community through charity, unity, fraternity, faith, and family activities.

MEN, AGE 18+

Lawn Care

Help mow, edge, trim, and care for the parish grounds during the growing season. Several schedules are available, and equipment is provided.

Lord's Diner

Serve people experiencing hunger by helping welcome guests, prepare or serve food, and clean the dining area. Volunteers serve on the 3rd Thursday of every month.

AGE 16+; YOUTH MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN.

Meals on Wheels

Deliver nutritious meals and a friendly visit to homebound older adults and people with disabilities.

Money Counter

Once a week, designated teams tally and record the parish Mass collections in accordance with established protocols. The individual must have a clean criminal record and consent to a background check.

PASTORAL APPROVAL

Our Lady of Guadalupe Events

Assist with the planning, preparation, hospitality, and celebration of parish events honoring Our Lady of Guadalupe.

Parish Dinner

Assist with planning, preparing, serving, setting up, or cleaning up for the annual Stewardship Appreciation Dinner.

Parish Events Group - Child Care

Provide supervised child care during selected parish events after completing all required training.

AGE 15+; VIRTUS REQUIRED

Parish Events Group - Planning

Assist with planning parish gatherings by assisting with schedules, volunteer roles, supplies, and logistics.

Parish Events Group - Setup

Move and arrange tables, chairs, signs, and supplies before parish events.

Photographer

Capture precious memories by taking photographs of chosen parish and school liturgies, programs, and events.

Respect Life Group

Promote the dignity of every human life through prayer, education, service, and participation in approved pro-life activities.

School Cafeteria Aide

Support the school cafeteria program by helping students, monitoring the cafeteria, and assisting with cleanup. M-F Breakfast or lunch schedules available.

School Cleaning

Help clean, organize, paint, move items, or prepare classrooms and common spaces for the school year. Flexible schedules available.

School Events

Assist with selected school celebrations, family events, appreciation activities, and special programs.

School Nurse Aide

Help care for students who visit the health room and assist school staff with approved health-room tasks. M-F Flexible schedules available.

VIRTUS REQUIRED

Snow Removal

Assist with clearing snow and treating ice on parish and school walkways as weather conditions require. Volunteers must be available to arrive early in the morning following overnight snowfall.

YOUTH MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN.

St. Anne Festival

Support the annual festival through planning, setup, food service, activities, hospitality, cleanup, or other assigned roles.

St. Michael Ministry

Support church safety, security, and emergency response during parish activities after professional training.

AGE 18+; APPROVAL/TRAINING

St. Vincent de Paul Society

Support neighbors in need by providing assistance with essential services such as food, housing, utilities, and other basic necessities.

Video

Record or edit approved parish videos, livestreams, testimonies, formation content, or event highlights.

APPOINTED MINISTRIES

These ministries are appointment by the pastor and serve the governance and mission of St. Anne.

Finance Council

Advise the pastor on parish finances, budget priorities, stewardship of resources, and major financial decisions.

Pastoral Council

Promote, support, and facilitate the mission of the parish under the guidance and authority of the pastor.

Pastoral Leadership Team

Work closely with the pastor to discern priorities, align parish efforts, and support mission-focused leadership.

School Council

Provide input and counsel to the pastor and school administration in support of St. Anne Catholic School.

Stewardship Council

Cultivate stewardship as a way of life by helping parishioners recognize, receive, and share God’s gifts. Assist with education, annual renewal, communications, and events while supporting ministry leaders with rosters, member follow-up, and ministry needs.
